ARE[®] Transition Chart

The Architect Registration Examination[®] is changing for the better. In July 2008, NCARB will launch ARE 4.0. This latest version of the exam updates and improves the current format by combining graphic and multiple choice content in six of the seven divisions. The goal of ARE 4.0 is to better integrate the examination while improving the assessment of a candidate's knowledge, skill, and ability to practice architecture independently.

If you have passed at least one division of ARE 3.1 before May 2008, you will have until

June 2009 to pass all remaining divisions of ARE 3.1. If you pass all divisions before the end of the one year overlap, you will not have to take any division of ARE 4.0.

If you do not pass all of the nine divisions of ARE 3.1 before June 2009, you will be transitioned to ARE 4.0. Please use this chart to determine which divisions you will need to take should you not complete ARE 3.1.
